

## NABSSAR Lamb/Sheep Registration Checklist

Registration Information Page - http://www.nabssar.org/registry.php Filling Out the Form, Step-by-Step Guide - http://www.nabssar.org/registration\_transfer\_form\_guide.php Must be an active member (membership for the year registering has been completed). http://www.nabssar.org/membership.php The sire and the dam of the lamb must be registered with us. Check our breed standard. Does the lamb have any disqualifying faults? If so, it cannot be registered with us. Print Version - http://www.nabssar.org/breed standard.php Photo Version - http://www.nabssar.org/breed standard with photos.php Attach one of your assigned official federal ID tags (scrapie tag). Two piece tags should be inserted with the female side (button) on the inside of the ear. This helps not only with retainability; but, in most instances, will result in the complete tag ID number (both flock ID and animal ID) being visible on the inside of the ear resulting in the head shot / ear tag photo requirement being easier to complete. Take a head shot / ear tag photo. What should they look like? Examples - http://www.nabssar.org/ear tag photo examples.php Fill out the Registration and Transfer Form. If you are registering and transferring at the same time, be sure and fill out the line stating seller transferring to (Name, Address, Phone #). Include both the registration fee and the transfer fee. Certificates will be mailed to you. You then mail them to your buyer. If you want them mailed directly to your buyer, you must request this.
